For the last ten years, the Greater Moncton Hospice Society has been dedicated to establishing a free standing ten bed Hospice. A Hospice Shoppe was created as a means to develop a source of funding first to substantiate the ability to have an ongoing supplemental operating funding for the Hospice but initially to build the founding funds for the capital campaign. Since inauguration, they have been very successful with the Shoppe moving it to a bigger more central location, achieving the required start-up funding for the Capital Campaign and meeting the requirements of the Lions Club who are providing the site for the new Hospice.

The Military and Hospitaller Order of St. Lazarus of Jerusalem, Acadia Commandery has been a steady financial supporter of the Society's needs for equipment, shelving and communication materials. Our latest donation was to enable them to have a computer, dictaphone and various other equipment for their Narrative Care Program which, with the help of their volunteers, allows families and loved ones to build a legacy story. In addition a large supply of Caregivers Guides was provided for their families.
