The renovations were completed late September/early October. The sun shade is constructed from Western Red Cedar and is a pergola structure with a retractable awning.

The Palliative Care Unit of CEHHC has six bedrooms, a kitchen, sun room, various family spaces serving catchment area of 75,000 people with an aging population. The
