Jun 03: It is now official! The Atalanta Hospice Society is now a registered charitable organization via the Canada Revenue Agency. This will change a few things, most notably, the Friends of the Order annual dues can now be submitted directly to the AHS through its own CanadaHelps.org account relieving the overhead of account management by the Order and having the funds re-directed to the AHS.
