Summer of 2023: The Acadia Commandery will curate a captivating and unparalleled fundraising



event supporting the Atalanta Hospice Society's Fundy Hospice initiative to be integrated with Digby's Scallop Days (August 10-13, 2023) and/or Lobster Bash (July 7-9, 2023) infusing the festivities with a distinct medieval flare. This event will be called "Hurling for Hospice" and will include a 12th century style of traction trebuchet,

which will hurl melons or squash into the Annapolis Basin. Each "hurl" will require a team of 5 individuals, each encouraged to make a donation of \$5 to support the cause, resulting in a cash contribution of \$25 per "hurl". Total funds accumulated will be petitioned to national to match those funds and donate to the Atalanta Hospice Society. The hours of operation is estimated to be 11am - 4pm, Friday, Saturday and Sunday at each festival. We hope that the Friends of the Order would pop-in to check out the trebuchet, and attempt a hurl themselves! We expect to be operational on the Friday, Saturday and Sunday between 11am and 4pm.
